• Objective: to create an intensive program that uses innovative learning and teaching methods, including the use of online cooperation.

### Conditions:

- Minimum 3 HEI from 3 different program countries
- Short-term physical mobility abroad (5-30 days) + mandatory virtual component facilitating collaborative online learning exchange and teamwork.
- Minimum of 15 participants
- Financing of the travel, accommodation, food: STA/STT → check with the international offices of your universities!
